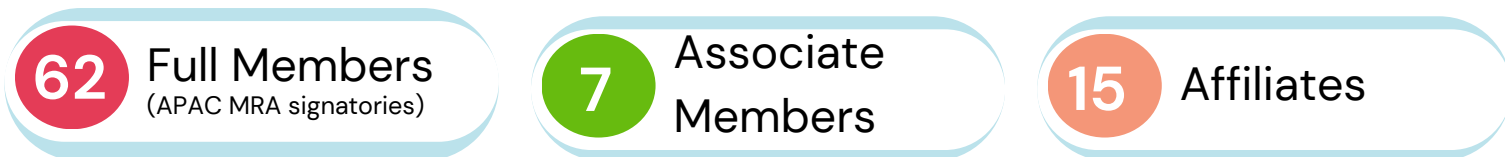


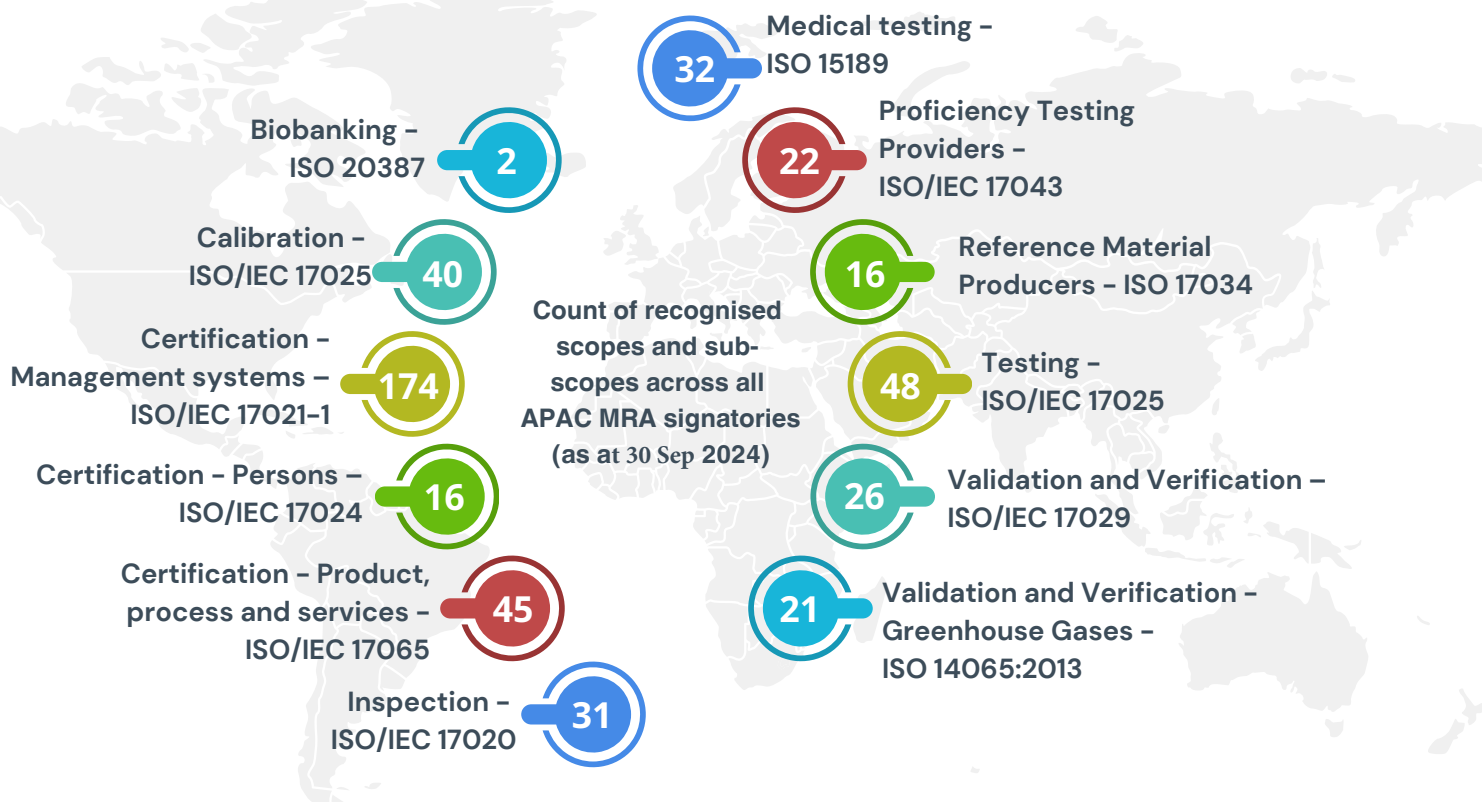
ASIA PACIFIC ACCREDITATION COOPERATION (APAC)

The Asia Pacific Accreditation Cooperation Incorporated (APAC) is the regional accreditation cooperation of accreditation bodies for the Asia Pacific region. It is recognised by the International Accreditation Forum (IAF) and the International Laboratory Accreditation Cooperation (ILAC). APAC's primary role is to manage and expand a mutual recognition arrangement (MRA) among accreditation bodies in the Asia Pacific region. The MRA facilitates the acceptance of conformity assessment results (e.g. test reports, test certificates, inspection reports, and certification) across the region and with other regions around the world.

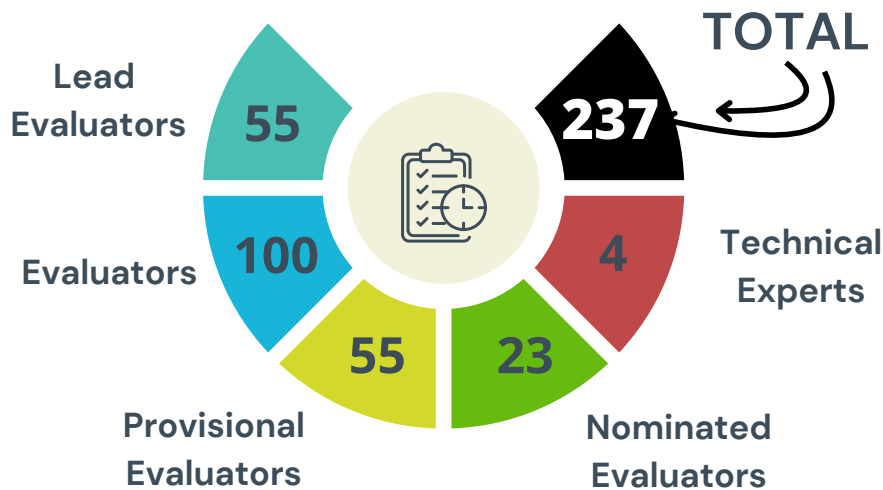

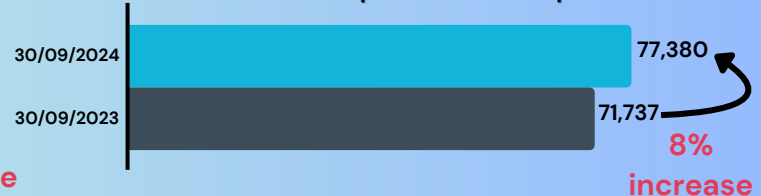


Accredited scopes and sub-scopes

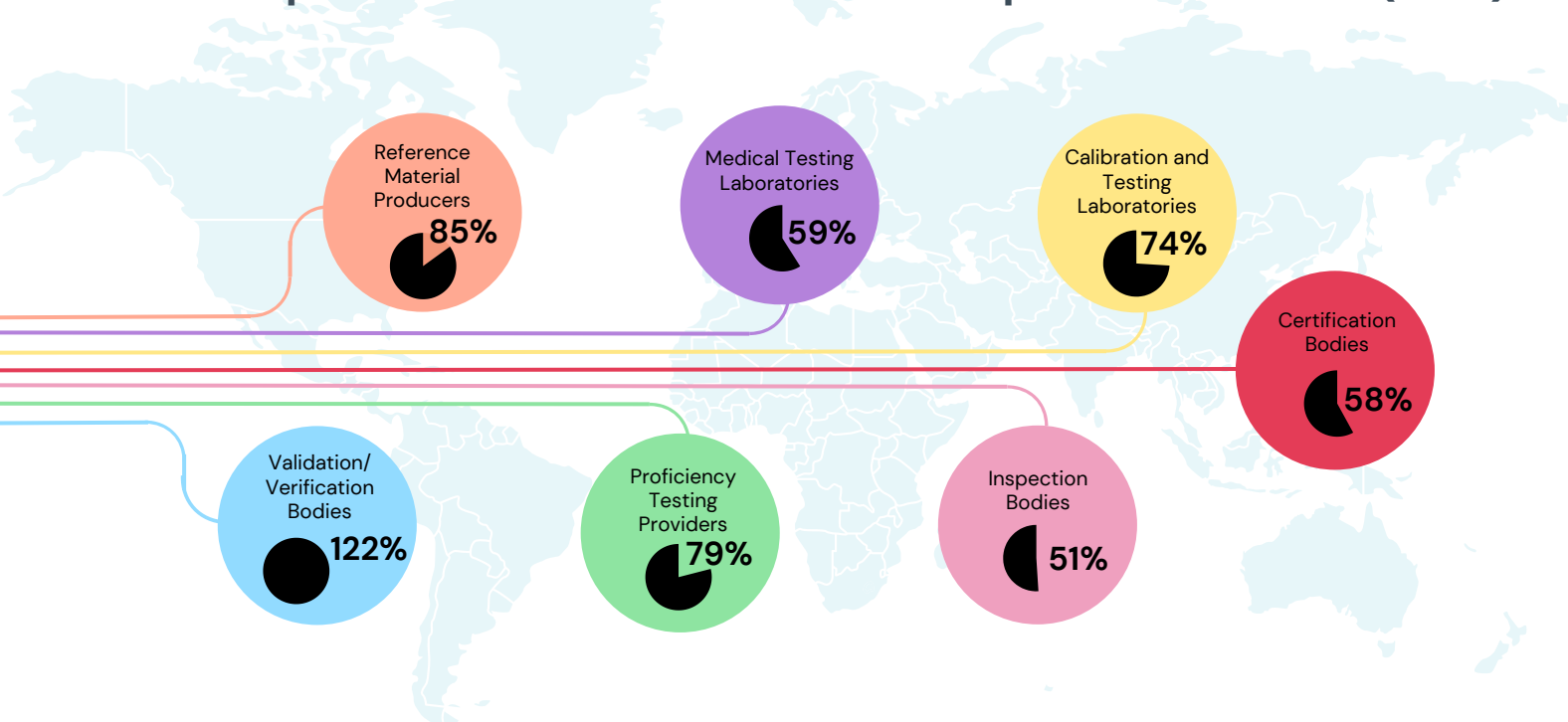
IAF-related scopes and sub-scopes
